COPY OF RULES – PART A

Current as at 28th February 2009.

RULE 1 NAME

The name of the incorporated Association (in these rules called 'the Association')

STUDEBAKER CAR CLUB OF QUEENSLAND INC.

RULE 2 OBJECTS

The objects for which the Association is established are –

1. To promote and foster the interests of owners of Studebakers, drivers and enthusiasts and the consideration and free discussion of all matters and questions relating or affecting the interests of owners of Studebakers, drivers and enthusiasts.
2. To promote friendship and courtesy on the road socially between members of the club and other drivers.
3. To promote and engender social activities.
4. To conduct meetings whereby members may obtain knowledge enabling them to become better drivers and to maintain their vehicles to a high standard of efficiency.
5. To establish rules and regulations for the proper conduct of members of the Club and for terminating their membership for just cause.
6. To form and maintain a library of books, journals and other literature dealing with matters of interest to members of the Club and to procure the delivery of lectures on such subjects.
7. To establish an information centre for use of all members with regard to availability of both new and used spare parts and adaptability of different models and of compiling a register of such information.
8. To organise exhibitions and demonstrations in relation to and lectures on subjects of educational value either to the members of the Club or the public generally.
9. To print and publish any newspapers, periodicals, books or leaflets for the promotion of its objects.
10. To provide suitable premises for meetings and carrying on the work of a complete organisation for the purpose of carrying into effect the objects of the Club.

RULE 3

POWERS

The powers of the Association are –

- (a) To take over the funds and other assets and liabilities of the present unincorporated Association known as the
