## **SOCIAL ORGANISER'S REPORT**

Ross advised that runs had been planned for the next 3 months and associated run sheets had been posted on the Web Site. Ross added that the variety of runs provided ample opportunities for members wishing to get their cars out of the garage; additionally, the run sheets showed our Club's support for similar car clubs in SEQ.

Ross provided the following summary of Club activities for the month:

For SCCQ, impromptu runs would be publicised on the Club Facebook Page. After a general discussion Ross advised that he would compile a procedure for members to follow should they wish to create an impromptu run for themselves and other club members.

Moonah Park Aged Care Facility, Mitchelton. Ross advised that he had received a request via Facebook for Club members to visit and display their vehicles to residents at the facility. There was general

agreement that a visit would be possible if a suitable date could be agreed upon in late November.

The article highlighted the dilemma facing most classic car clubs – ageing, diminishing memberships. The article suggested that the future survival of car clubs may involve merging with other clubs or at least affiliating with other clubs.
