Harold and Phyllis Ireland informed the meeting of the recent passing of SA Club Member, Marty (Mart) Mardiste.

Harold told the meeting that after WW2, The Mardiste Family immigrated from Estonia to the Pine Rivers area of SE Qld. After Mart finished school, he began working as an apprentice motor mechanic for Harold's father, Walter. In those days Pine Rivers was a farming area and Mart's work involved the maintenance and repair of the trucks and cars of local farmers. Harold commented that new cars and trucks were relatively scarce at this time and Walter and Mart were responsible for full restorations of vehicles from the 20's, 30's and 40's. Of course, there were Studebakers in this mix including Mart's daily driver, a '38 Studebaker Commander.

Phyllis fondly added that Mart would also help Harold's mother with milking the household's 13 cows. When Harold began his transport business, Mart would often lend a hand with large deliveries. In particular, the distribution of water pipes for the reticulated water supply in Pine Rivers.

Both Harold and Phyllis emphasised Mart's kindness and willingness to lend a helping hand. Harold concluded that Mart's early years in Australia created cherished memories for the lifelong friends he made in and around Pine Rivers. Rest in Peace Mart.
