## **GENERAL BUSINESS**

QHMC Report: Doug Murphy provided feedback on two issues that have been discussed in recent months at the QHMC meetings: The Vehicles Written Off Scheme, and the Use of Vehicles with Special Registration for Ceremonial Purposes.

Regarding the Vehicles Written Off Scheme, Doug advised that TMR Qld is considering removing the current 16yr limit for vehicles that are written off. This would impact upon all Veteran, Vintage and Classic Vehicles and QHMC has recommended that an age limit of 30 yrs would be more realistic. Doug added that Clubs were encouraged to write to the TMR Qld and QHMC would assist with guidelines for letters.

For Club Members wishing to use their vehicles with Special Registration for ceremonial purposes, Doug advised that this service could only be provided for immediate family and that no fee could be charged.

Xmas Party: Sheree advised that a set menu with a Xmas dinner theme was being investigated along with an optional restricted menu for those attendees not wanting the Xmas dinner. A \$10.00 limit would be set for the secret Santa gifts.

Club Shirts: Sheree suggested that Club shirts should be available for sale at the Show and Shine in October. After a short discussion attendees agreed that a run of 20 shirts should be purchased. Sheree and Janelle to organise.
